

ST. NICHOLAS MITER TREAT CUP

MATERIALS

White, ivory or red cover or cardstock
White or red cupcake papers, *optional*
Red or purple markers, colored pencils or crayons
Gold marker, colored pencil, or crayon
Dry film adhesive dispenser, such as *Tombo MonoAdhesive* or *Liquid Paper DryLine*



EQUIPMENT

Printer or copier
Scissors

DIRECTIONS

1. Print pattern (2 pieces if using printed base) on cardstock with printer or copier. Base and miter should be on the same color paper, unless using cupcake papers for base.
2. If using white/ivory cardstock, color miter and cut out. If using red, decorate with metallic gold marker or gold foil paper and cut out.
3. Cut out the round base pattern along dotted line. Snip out "V's" to make tabs. Fold tabs up (flat circle sits on work surface; folded tabs stand up (making a shallow cup).

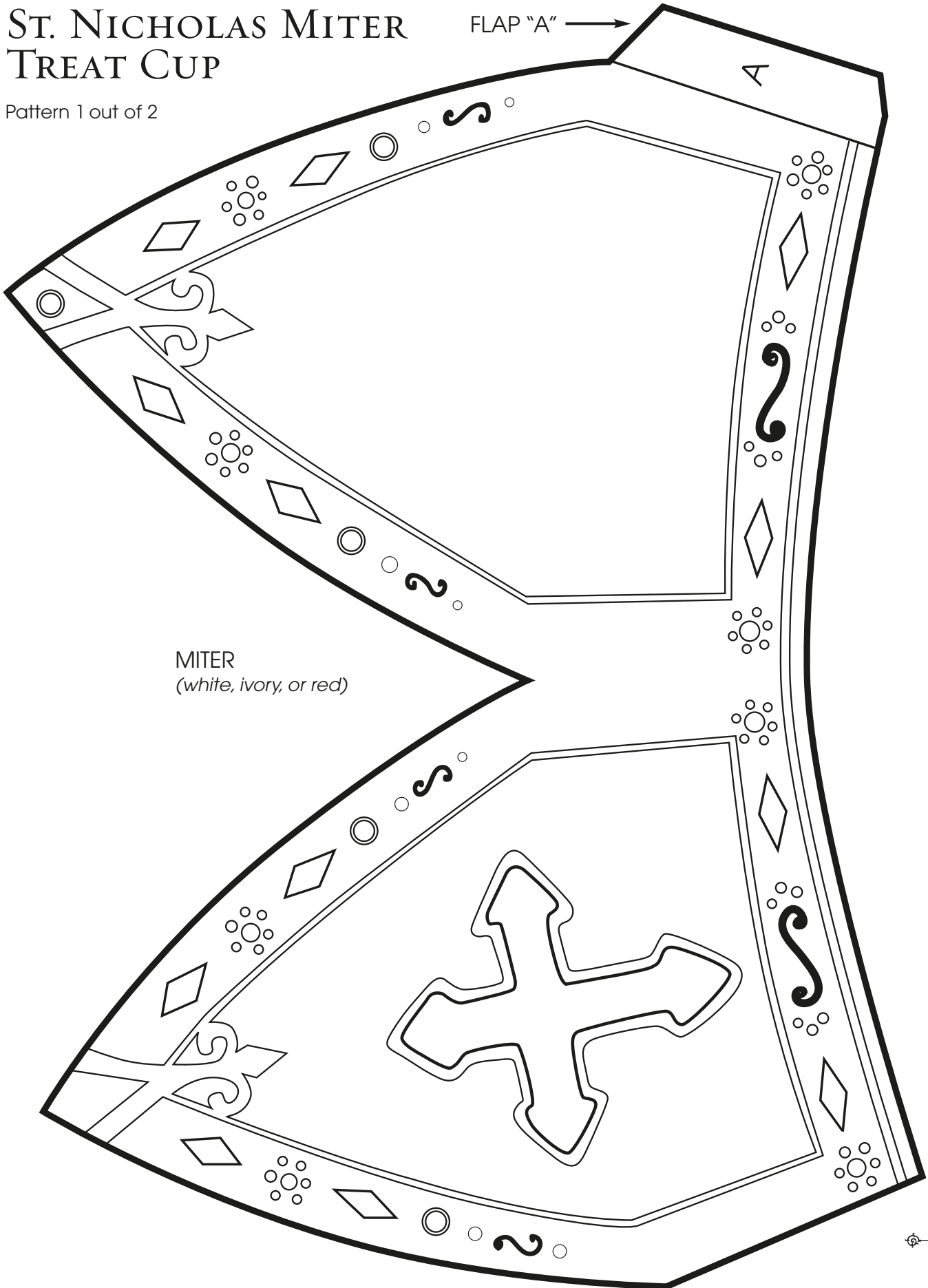
Use cupcake papers to form base.

4. Put miter wrong-side-up on work surface; fold miter flap "A" towards back of miter. Put dry adhesive on right side of flap "A" (so adhesive faces out).
5. Keeping miter wrong-side-up, apply adhesive in a strip along the entire lower edge
6. Pick up base, stick one tab firmly in place on end of miter with flap. Roll miter around base, pressing tabs into place as you go. Press side edge of miter onto adhesive on flap "A".
The bottom of the base should be flush with the miter's lower edge. Make sure all adhesive is firmly pressed in place.
7. Fill with treats: clementine or tangerine, candy, small surprises.

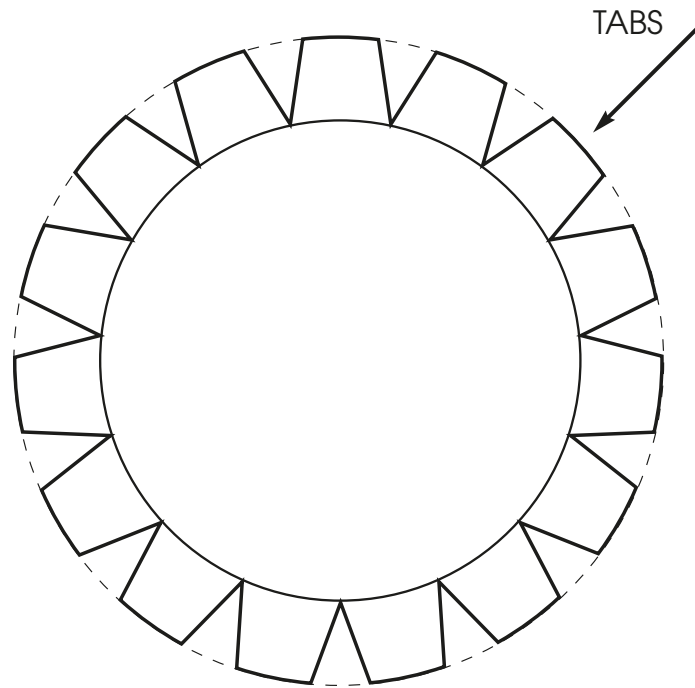
FLAP "A" →
